Administrative Order No. 2020-13

WHEREAS, due to the outbreak of the coronavirus, COVID-19, and consistent with guidance issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Maryland Department of Health, an emergency exists that poses a threat of harm to individuals in Maryland who seek to enter a court or judicial facility and come into contact with personnel; and

WHEREAS, as the COVID-19 emergency continued, public health strategies appearing to have been effective in reducing the transmission rate in Maryland and such restrictions gradually having been lessened, the resumption of certain judicial functions became possible, with the implementation of safeguards as advised by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Maryland Department of Health; and

WHEREAS, on November 12, 2020, the Chief Judge of the Maryland Court of Appeals issued a Fifth Administrative Order Restricting Statewide Judiciary Operations Due To The COVID-19 Emergency, in response to positivity rates that appear to have significant upward trajectories; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 positivity rates for the State of Maryland exceed 9.0%. and the rates for Baltimore City exceed 5.0%. The Governor of the State of Maryland and the Mayor of the City of Baltimore have imposed new restrictions on the operations of businesses, and there is an increase in the number of patients hospitalized with COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, two-way live video remote proceedings are useful and effective in protecting the wellbeing of those who have matters before the Circuit Court for Baltimore City while protecting the essence of a defendant's right to confront witnesses absent a physical face-to-face

confrontation and the reliability of the testimony is assured given the quality of the video technology now in existence; it is hereby

ORDERED, that in an effort to protect the health and safety of the public, employees, to address wellness concerns raised by members of the Bar and to resolve matters efficiently, effective Tuesday, December 1, 2020, all pretrial hearings scheduled before the Criminal Division of the Circuit Court for Baltimore City, shall be held remotely using two-way live video technology; it is further

ORDERED, that this Administrative Order shall remain in effect until rescinded by the undersigned.
